2. MINOR MEDICAL RELEASE - This form must be completed with the appropriate required signatures for all riders under age 19 years. All minors (under age 19) must carry this card as you ride on BRAN 30.

3. BRAN LUGGAGE TAGS - Two BRAN tags are included and should be placed on each piece of luggage to be carried on the BRAN baggage truck. Remember, limit 2 bags per rider at 40 lb. each. For packing tips and details, refer to the Survival Guide posted on www.bran-inc.org.

4. SAFETY & COURTESY GUIDELINES - Overall bicycle safety is a primary concern for riders on BRAN and whenever you are on your bicycle. As part of our safety campaign, BRAN has developed a list of Ten Rules of Safety and Etiquette when riding your bicycle.

Vehicle Registration - Vehicles accompanying BRAN riders are required to be registered to have access to the parking areas at the host community campgrounds. A limited number of vehicle passes will be issued at a cost of \$50 per vehicle. Vehicle Packets and registration will be available Saturday at the check-in area.



Bus Riders - A reminder - Buses will start loading at **5:30am** and leave at **6:30am**, Saturday, June 5th at the Strategic Air and Space Museum.



BRAN Bus Captains will be directing the loading process. Bikes will be loaded on the semi first, then riders will park their cars. Riders and gear will be loaded onto the buses in the vehicle parking area at Strategic Air and Space Museum.

BRAN RIDE TICKET: Required at check-in to receive your Official BRAN Rules, Wristband ID, BRAN 30 Water Bottle, T-shirt, Rider Number, and BRAN Serial.

Note: *If you intend to join the ride later in the week, check in at Camp Headquarters the evening of your arrival.*

FOOD - Meals are not included. However, host communities and towns along the route have church and other service organizations planning to prepare meals and snacks at reasonable cost for the riders, in addition to local restaurants. Check the Tour Guide for various offerings.

CAMPING - BRAN is a camping trip. Each overnight stop has a designated camp area with restrooms and showers. The camp areas will be on school grounds or public parks. Therefore, alcohol is prohibited and will not be tolerated in these areas. Remember, we are guests in these communities.
